1) Prohibited dog breeds.

The following breeds are not permitted in Iceland:

Hybrids from wolves and dogs for at least 10 generations. The following dog breeds, as well as their cross breeds for at least 5 generations. 1) Pit Bull Terrier/American Staffordshire Terrier/Staffordshire Bull Terrier/American Bulldog, 2) Fila Brasileiro, 3) Tosa Inu, 4) Dogo Argentino, 5) Cane Corso, 6) Presa Canario, 7) Boerboel. Dogs with a comparable origin, physique and / or temperament as banned breeds. MAST shall justify its decision and take into account the available information on the dog breed in question, its origin and breeding standards, physique and temperament.. If in doubt about the type of dog you are planning to import, please contact MAST for further information.
