



Amendment to regulation 200/2020 on the import of dogs and cats to Iceland regarding the method of transport permitted.

MAST would like to inform you that as off the 8th December 2025, an amendment has been made to the regulation on the import of dogs and cats:

Both cats and dogs are now allowed to be transported in the cabin of the plane when being imported to Iceland (subject to airline policies and prior approval by MAST).

AVIÖR, which is dedicated to the aviation security at KEF, will be taking care of the cabin pets on arrival, collecting them from the arrival gate and transporting them to the reception centre at Icelandair Cargo.

MAST is looking forward to this co-operation and hope the import process will be smooth for everyone involved.
