- 4) Your service dog must be treated with a veterinary medicinal product licensed for the treatment of fleas and other external parasites no more than 120 hours and no less than 24 hours before the flight to Iceland. This treatment must be registered in your service dog's vaccination booklet/passport and submitted to customs or airport staff upon request.
- 5) Your service dog may under no circumstances leave the airport and enter the country. This will be considered illegal importation.
